THE NÜRBURGRING GRAND PRIX TRACK

One of the most famous circuits in Europe is Nürburgring and the original track was build between 1925 and 1927, 3000 unemployed men worked hard for two years to complete the layout that measure over 20 km`s.

The modern Grand Prix track that we and Formula One are using is a totally different story and was completed in 1984, with a major change four years ago. If the old "Nordschleife" is one of the more thrilling sequences of turns You can find on earth is the new Grand Prix track not very challenging but still I like it and for the spectators it is quite good regarding viewing possibilities.

Nürburg is located in the Eifel mountains and the closest neighbour is the Ardennes where You fin another famous racetrack Spa Francorchamps. Like in Spa the weather is very unpredictable and changes so quickly, sometimes it even rains on one part of the circuit and the sun is out on the other side.

Ferrari Racing Days Nürburgring

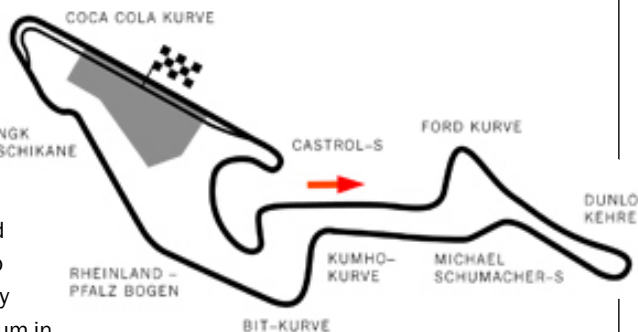


Do you remember this guy? This weekend he will drive one of his old F1 cars at the Nürburgring.
