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1 Welcome

Please note that this document has no regularity power and are only to be considered as information. This document, Rally Guide 1, is mainly produced for the teams, competitors and media and contains information necessary for the preparation before the event. Further information will be given in the supplementary regulations, and later in the Rally Guide 2.

1.1 East Sweden Rally

East Sweden Rally is the final round of the European Trophy Baltic (ERT) and also included in Swedish Rally Championship 2019. The rally will take place 6-7 September in the region of Östergötland with Linköping as HQ. The HQ as well the service park is located at Saab Arena.

The rally has a total length of approximately 399 km with 11 stages over 110 km, with one super special stage, on tarmac, driven two times on Friday. The rally will be divided into three legs, one on Friday and two on Saturday. It will be possible to restart both after leg one and leg two. All stages are gravel except the super special stage: 98 % gravel, 2 % tarmac

Östgöta classes will run the stages on Saturday, SS7-S11 and has a total length of approximately 230 km with 5 stages over 58 km.

4 Service parc

4.1 Service parc

The main service parc for the entire rally will be located at HQ Saab Arena in Linköping and will be open from 07.00 Friday morning, September 6th. If requested to park already on Thursday, contact Service Area Manager.

We have a limited area for service. For that reason, we have to thoroughly plan the service parc. Each team will receive a fixed location on the service area fitted for a service vehicle of VW Crafter

model (7 m. long) and a mobile tent with a size of 3x6 m. There will be no place for caravans / motorhomes at the Service Park. There is a possibility to get bigger service area, but the charge will be 50 sek/sqm and has to be booked in advance.

Following must be reported to Service Area Manager before Monday August 26th 18:00:

- If you need bigger area than above mentioned service vehicle and tent combination.
- If you want to stand beside a certain competitor.
- If you have a marquee or a tent that are mounted on your service vehicle.

Unloading of race car and parking of trailer are done at designated area before you enter the service park. One (1) service vehicle is allowed on the service park if nothing else has been agreed with service park manager. Each team has one (1) parking space for a car (eg Recce car) close to the service park. Other vehicles have to be parked at designated parking areas according to state and local law.

There will be no space or time to make any changes during the race. When you arrive to service park you will be shown to your service area by an officer.

6 Fuel / Tyres

6.1 Regulations regarding tyres which may be used during the rally

See Article 60 and Appendix V of the 2019 FIA Regional Rally Championship Sporting Regulations (RRSR) (Tyres and wheels).



6.2 National laws or special requirements

6.2.1 Swedish championship

Tires allowed are according to the present Swedish championship regulations.

Maximum quantities of tyre is 8.

It is possible to have 4 extra tires labelled, these tires can only be used on SS 1 and SS2, the super special stage on tarmac.

6.2.2 Östgöta classes

Östgöta classes, free number of tires and according to SBF tire list.

6.3 Fuel

During section 2 and 3 on Saturday, there will be a possibility to refuel in remote refuel zones along the route.

The responsibility for refuelling is on the competitor. Engine needs to be switched off during refuelling. Safety belt is not allowed to be used if the crew is in the car.

7 Import of vehicles and spare parts

7.1 From the European Union.

Competitors from the European Union do not need to make any special custom clearance for temporary import of cars and equipment on arrival in Sweden.

7.2 From outside the European Union

If you are importing the rally car, service cars and/or spare parts/equipment from outside the European Union you have to report to the customs on arrival in Sweden. 17.3 Media Accreditation at the event

Accreditation on site during the East Sweden Rally will take place in the Press Center on floor 3 during opening hours Friday 12-21 and Saturday 7.30 - about 18. On site you will be welcomed by local press host or press officer who will receive your application and will provide you with everything you need for the competition. You receive magazine, map, parking permit and press pass for the stages.

17.4 Media center

The press center is located a few floors up in the Saab Arena with panoramic windows beyond the service area. At the far end of the service area is the start of the super special stage, which can also be seen from the press center. The way to the press center is signposted from the Infodisk in the foyer of the Saab Arena.

Press center is staffed by the press officer during the specified opening hours. The press center includes access to results and the internet.

18 Medical and safety service

18.1 Medical information for Sweden

Citizens from the EU/EEA - countries will receive emergency medical care paying the same patient charge as Swedish citizens. Competitors from these countries must provide an European Health Insurance Card verifying that the person is covered by health insurance, when medical care is required, and should obtain this form before leaving their home country. Citizens from the Nordic countries are not required to provide the European Health Insurance Card.

Besides the EU/EEA-countries Sweden has an agreement with the following countries which guarantees the citizens emergency medical care at the same patient charge as Swedish citizens: Algeria and Australia. Competitors from these countries must also provide an European Health Insurance Card, EU card or corresponding document verifying that the person is covered by health insurance. Citizens in other countries than mentioned above have to pay the total cost of treatment plus the patient charge.

Appendix 5 – Safety tracking system

GPS for security, monitoring, and timekeeping

Safety tracking system will be used during ESR for all competitors including for Östgötaclasses.

Tracking of team will be applied incl. speed control during the reconnaissance according to Swedish Championship regulation, Rally SM 2019, which means we will use Racetimings GPS / tracking equipment. The following equipment will be assembled to have the right connector installed in the race car when you get to the rally.

A GPS is distributed at the time of registration and will be used both during the reconnaissance and the race. During the reconnaissance, it will be monitored that the drive through of the SS will take place not more than 2 times and that the speed is maintained according to the supplementary regulations. Violations will be punished by supplementary regulations. During the competition, the system is used as a safety feature to monitor where the race car is located.

At reconnaissance, GPS must be switched on when the reconnaissance car is in motion as well as during the race on Friday from start ramp (TC0) to finish (TC 10A).

Everything will be returned when arriving parc fermé after finish (or return of log-book)

Connectors and installation

In the reconnaissance car, the GPS is connected via the cigarette lighter socket, while in the race car the competitor must prepare a constant 12V connector.

In order for the system to function, constant current must be in the rally car (directly from the battery) Swedish regulations have been modified by this requirement.

Be sure to connect directly to +12 VDC with 5A fuse protection on cable. The length of the cabling must be such that the connector can be placed in the interior compartment, on or close to the rear strut tower or equivalent.

The ignition connection must also be connected to + 12 VDC.

The connector is connected as follows:

Pin 1 12 V permanent (not fractured by main swith)
Pin 2 Ground
Pin 3 Ignition

Mounting

Rally car - mount the device on any rear tube of the roll cage with tape or equal, but not "silver tape", so the top of the unit "looks" up / out through the rear side window, not lower than the bottom of the window.

Secure the connection board with tape or equal, so do not loosen from the device

If an external GPS antenna is included, mount it on the roof, secure with a tape, and "pinch" the cable gently into the rear door / back cover and connect it to the connector on the device



Alternate mounting can be done on the hat rack or corresponding roll cage details so that the unit is cleared through the rear window, but not lower than the bottom of the window.
