By entering the Midnattssolsrallyt, the driver, the co-driver, the entrant and the team's service crew, give the organiser the right to register and publish the name of the driver, Co-driver, entrant and service crew regardless the way of media.

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# 9 DESCRIPTION OF THE RALLY

The Midnattssolsrallyt is a national regularity rally arranged in accordance with the Swedish ANS regularity regulations. The regularity stages are on closed stages. The total length of the rally is **appr 800 km with 17 stages with a total of appr 152 km**. Most of the stages are on gravel. The rally is divided into 3 legs with 3 night rest halts. The rally is driven with roadbook.

The starting interval is 1 minute. Regularity will have the same starting order during the entire rally. Regularity has the following classes 28 - 33.

The presence of any member of the crew on the roads use in the rally is not allowed after the publication of this supplementary regulations/invitation.

# **12 COMPETITORS – LICENSE CLASSES- ELIMINATION**

Competitors in regularity rally shall have a valid license (EU-license). Temporary license for driver and Co-driver, issued by the organiser, may be ordered at your entry at a cost of 350:- SEK/license incl. VAT. The licenses are to be collected at the rally info. The Co-driver must be at least 13 years old. The maximum number of entrants in the classes Regularity and Historic Rally is totally 175.

# N.B. THE FOLLOVING ROLES APPLY:

In all competitions, except in FIA-championship event, shall one and the same driver, drive the car during the whole rally. The crew consists of driver and co-driver; they have to be together during the whole rally and may not be changed. Driver and co-driver may only take part once in the same competition regardless of function

# **METHOD OF ELIMINATION:**

The organiser claims their right to eliminate freely.

# **13 CLASSES – STARTING ORDER**

The regularity will compete in the following classes 28 - 33.

Cars made before 31<sup>st</sup> December 1990 and apply to Swedish ASN Regularity rules. This means that the car have to be equipped with at least standard safety belts. If the cars, at moment of production, were not equipped with at safety belt; must at least a 3-point safety belt be mounted to driver and co-drivers seats.

In open cars, must the crew wear helmets during driving on special stages.

The car must be equipped with at least one 2 kilo fire-extinguisher, first-aid kit and warning reflecting triangle.

At service of the car you must place a tarpaulin under the car.

**STARTINGORDER:** In regularity starts class Sport first and then class Elite. After the regularity classes starts the historic rally. The regularity classes will start in the same order during the entire rally.

# **CLASSES:**

The regularity is divided into the following classes 1 – 3, Sport and Elite.

Class 1:	Cars produced before 1960
Class 2:	Cars produced between 1961 and 1974
Class 3:	Cars produced from 1975 and on wards

The competitors may by them self-choose, at the moment of entry, class Sport or Elite; according to their on ambition and whished degree of difficulty. The lady class is placed in class Elite.





#### **CLASS ELITE:**

This class is designed for experienced crew. In class Elite will the averaged speed vary and on the special stages there will be greater number of secret control. The speeds to be used will communicated in a Bulletin.

#### **CLASS SPORT:**

This class is designed for the enthusiasts. Class Sport will mostly use an average speed of 50 km/h on the special stages; and will also have less number of secret controls.

The average speed may be reduced on some parts of the special stages. This will be communicated in a Bulletin.

# **14 ADVERTISING**

The organiser claims their right, according to the Swedish ASN regulations, put adverting on the cars. The front doors, the front wings and the upper part of the front window will be used for the organisers advertising.

On the above mentioned parts of the car is it not allowed to have any other kind of advertising from the moment of scrutineering up to the finish of price giving. The advertising may not be removed during the competition.

The advertising rules regarding historic rally according to App. K shall be followed strictly.

Competitors/teams who wishes to have their own commercial activities, public events and/or exhibitions at the service park or along the rally route and at other places, must have a permit issued by the organiser and have to be given before last date of entry. #### **16 SPECIAL REGULATIONS**

On the 27<sup>th</sup> June, before the start of the rally, see time schedule under point 11, each car have to be scrutinized by the organizer. The cars registrations paper and insurances paper have to be presented.

The organiser will assign a test stage (appr. 10 km) to allow the competitors to calibrate their trip meters before start.

Tyres are free.

Competitors in the regularity classes have to follow the given average speed on the special stages. On liaison stages is the current speed limit has to be followed. If a competitor at several occasions exceeds the average speed on the special stages is at first a warning given and at further offence the crew will be excluded.

All trip meters approved by the Swedish ASN may be used. See the Swedish ASN rules and regulations. It is prohibited, in the competing car, to bring along or use electronic devices which could be used for navigation or measure the average speed; for example GPS devices, mobile phones, electronic time schedule. A mobile phone may be brought along, but has to be turned off and out of reach during the special stages.

The organiser claims their right to check that the rules are followed, at any time during the entire rally. Violation will lead to exclusion.





Timing at start and finish will be carried out by clocks and GPS technic, timing at the secret time controls will be carried out with the use of GPS technic. The finish line is not the same as in the competitors' road book.

Timing will on tens of a second. Changing of speed occur on most of the stages. The average speed will be given at arrival at the TC before each stage.

Penalty points according to the Swedish ASN regularity regulations, art. 5.7.9 English arrows and international signs will be used.

Start with electronic clock. In case of failure of the clock the start will be done with a flag. Results and restart list will be published after each leg. N.B. virtual notice board.

#### **RE-STARTING POSSIBILITY:**

A competitor who retires at the two first legs may re-start on the next leg after a usual scrutineering have been done. And a penalty of 300 points per SS that not has been completed plus 30 points per missed secret time control is given. But always a minimum of 300 points is given. The re-starting rules will also apply on competitors who have been excluded due to exceeding the time limits. A competitor who retires on leg 1, section 1 may re-start on leg 1 section 2. Notification of a possible re-start have to be given to Mr Lars Gren on phone +46-70-311 98 87 and according to the time schedule. The cars have to be scrutinised before restart. Please call the chief scrutineer. If a competitor retires on leg 3 the competitor will be regarded as retired from the event.

#### **SERVICE PARK:**

Each competitor who has given notice of need of a service area will be allocated a maximum area of 6 x 10 meter. If a regularity teams does not need a service area, there will be a normal parking lot allocated to the team. Extended service park area may be ordered when you do your entry. Regarding planned activities by the team at the Service Park, please look at point 14 advertising.

#### **ELECTRICITY**:

1-Phase 10 amp electricity is included in the entry fee, but may be rejected in the entry form; and has a value of SEK 500:-. The team that use electricity and have rejected this will receive a 30 sec. time penalty. Repeated use will result in a fine of 5 000:- SEK.

**PARC FERMÉ:** Mandatory overnight Park Fermé is not applicable after leg 1 and 2. Service is allowed until the start next morning. After finish on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> June is Parc Fermé mandatory, until the final results is posted. The competitor shall, without exemption, use their by the organiser given service area. The competitor may place their cars in the optional guarded parking each evening. The car may be collected from this area 30 minutes before the starting time, and may be driven to their service area or directly to the start TC.

Toilets and showers is available close to the Service e Park

Other Service Park's will occur along the route.

The environmental rules of service will apply according to the rules of the Swedish ASN. Final scrutineering will take place at finishing area in Vimmerby. Scrutineering will also occur after the finish of each leg.





**17 ENTRY FEE** 

The entry fee is 15 500:- SEK incl. 6% VAT. Date of payment see point 18 below.

#### **26 TARGET TIMES AND MAXIMAL TIMES**

According to the Swedish ASN regulations; the maximum time between two subsequent TC's is 15 minutes and the maximum lateness on a leg is 30 minutes or a maximum of 60 minutes for the entire rally.
